




ABOUT US

No Time for That Anti-Bullying Society (NTFT) is a registered Canadian charity that works with performers and motivational speakers to develop and deliver powerful presentations mainly to school-age children and youth about bullying prevention, mental health awareness, and LGBTQ2S+ visibility.

These presentations are part of the "No Time for That" Tour, which is a full production program including 45 minutes of speaking, live music performed by a band, video, and volunteer activities. There is a 15 minute Q&A period afterwards as well as the chance to meet the touring crew.

So far, we've delivered over 600 presentations with the "No Time for That" Tour to schools across Canada, at no cost to the schools.

Each school visit has been with our Founder and performing partner, award-winning Elsie Morden. Elsie shares her own experiences with bullying and mental illness through personal stories and original songs. She is also a national ambassador for Kids Help Phone. We distribute Kids Help Phone materials at each presentation to ensure that students and staff receive the resources and support that they need.

Today, while working on building our roster of performing partners, we're continuing our efforts of educating and empowering youth with Elsie Morden.





In November of 2020, we launched our NTFT Virtual Tour and it has been so incredible connecting with youth across the country! I definitely miss the in-person experience,

however speaking with students in British Columbia and Newfoundland on the same day is a benefit of doing the tour virtually! Plus, we have been able to virtually visit schools in very remote locations, therefore expanding our reach significantly. Thank you to everyone on our team and all of our supporters for making this happen.

We held our first NTFT (Virtual) Awards show in June of 2021. The winning schools were celebrated for achievements like putting on the first Pride parade in their town, committing to becoming better allies, and spreading kindness by sending cards and care packages to

mom_wife_dancer BULLYING IN THE BALLET. MY PERSONAL EXPERIENCE.

I grew up in Ukraine and I have been dancing since I was 3 years old. The environment I grew up in was pretty brutal. There was a lot of unhealthy competition and unattainable standards for children. When I was 10 years old I was accepted into a prestigious ballet school. This particular school was located in another country, very far from my hometown Kharkiv.

During the two years that I spent away from my family I was bullied by my classmates. I was humiliated as well emotionally and physically abused.

I would love to say that I was brave enough to overcome these emotions, but I wasn't. I was so scared of my peers that I never felt comfortable telling my mom anything. It wasn't until last year, after I gave birth to my daughter that I was able to speak to my mom openly. I was 24 years old! It is very difficult to express your real emotions to a crowd, especially when you are a child. Bullying leaves deep wounds in a child's heart.

I want to support the @ntftcanada charity organization, their CEO @elsiemorden, their volunteer @sarahjoe1 and the rest of the team as they educate kids about bullying and how it affects a child's mental health.
