No Time for That Anti-Bullying Society is a registered Canadian charity that works with performers and motivational speakers to develop and deliver powerful presentations mainly to school-age children and youth about bullying prevention, mental health awareness, and youth empowerment.

These presentations are part of the “No Time for That” Tour, which is a full production program including 45 minutes of speaking, live music performed by a band, video, and volunteer activities. There is a 15 minute Q&A period afterwards as well as the chance to meet the touring crew. So far, we’ve delivered over 600 presentations with the “No Time for That” Tour to schools across Canada, at no cost to the schools.

Each school visit has been with our Founder, CEO, and performing partner, award-winning Elsie Morden. Elsie shares her own experiences with bullying and mental illness through personal stories and original songs. She is also a national ambassador for Kids Help Phone. We distribute Kids Help Phone materials at each presentation to ensure that students and staff receive the resources and support that they need. Today, while working on building our roster of performing partners, we’re continuing our efforts of educating and empowering youth with Elsie Morden.

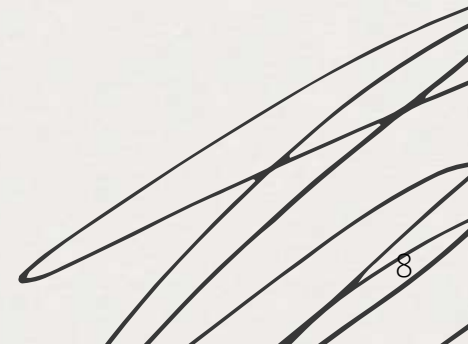
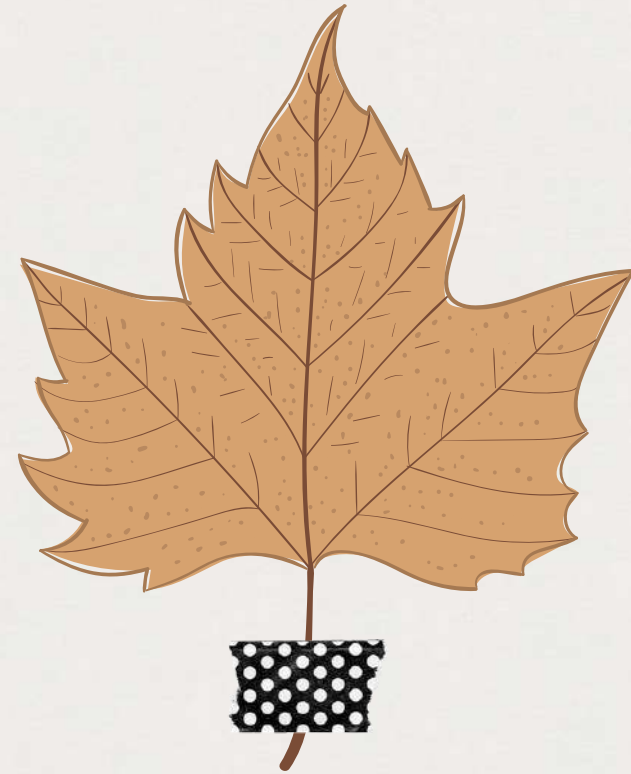


NTFT had its biggest year yet for bringing in funds due to the incredible generosity of our volunteers, donors, and community partners.

However, as reflected in our financials, our expenses exceeded our revenue for this fiscal year. While our small team worked hard, and continued to build relationships with sponsors and donors, we unfortunately didn't meet our fundraising and sponsorship target for the national tour in advance. Where we had worked diligently to plan and execute the tour, NTFT upheld our commitments to the program and youth education, and delivered the tour to 100 schools coast to coast.

While we made a strong attempt to continue to fundraise throughout the duration of the national tour, due to staffing constraints and logistics we fell short of our goal.

Our focus was on delivering professional and meaningful presentations the best we could to help youth in need, and we greatly exceeded our expectations in that area. The lessons learned that we take away from this fiscal year are ones of a strong commitment to our fundraising goals, and the importance of building a larger team. We are very proud of the existing relationships with donors that we maintained and the new ones that we created.





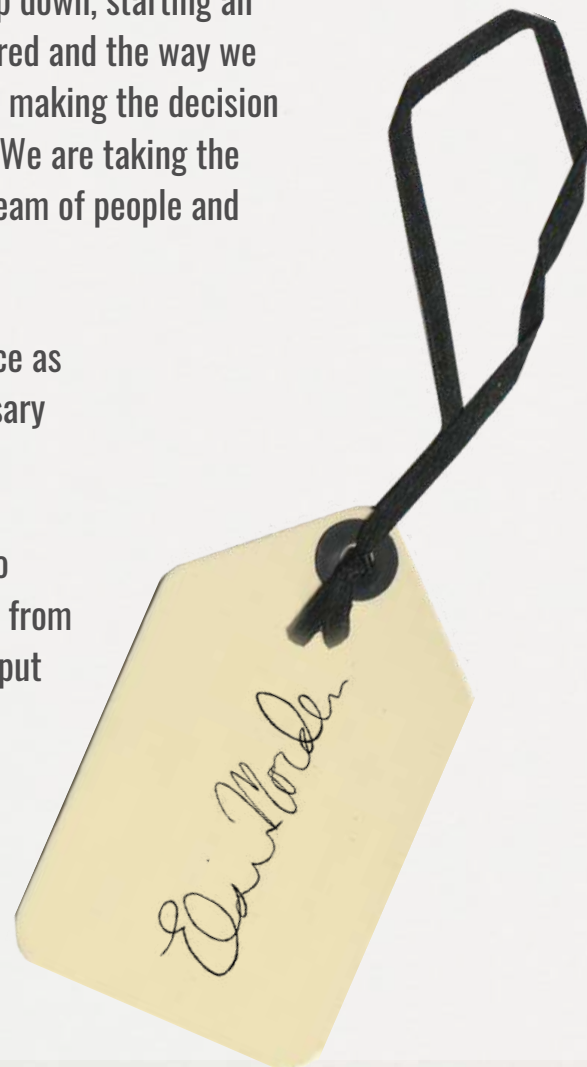
Beginning in the first few months of 2019, we invested our time and resources on focusing inward – on the organization itself: restructuring, strengthening the foundation, adjusting to make things more productive and efficient. This included a restructuring of our Board of Directors, and arriving at an agreement with the Executive Director to step down, starting an assessment of our governance models and how our programming is delivered and the way we can best deliver it moving forward, how we can better secure funding, and making the decision that now presentations will only be given if funds are secured in advance. We are taking the time to really lay down the necessary framework and establish the right team of people and funding to move us in the right direction and ensure definite success.

Thank you so much to all of our supporters for helping us make a difference as we continue to build our organization. We just celebrated our 4th anniversary as a registered charity and we couldn't have done it without you!
